WHAT IS THE BRIDGE PROGRAM?

The Bridge program is a low cost wellness service SICSA offers to pet owners and stray pet finders who are looking to rehome their pets. Participation is completely optional and will not change your place on our waiting list or guarantee your pet placement in our adoption program.

WHY SHOULD I USE THIS SERVICE?

- Peace of mind. If you have brought found or stray animals into your home, you may want to have them see by a vet before introducing them to your current animals. The Bridge program allows your pets to receive veterinary services at a discounted cost.
- SICSA veterinarians may be able to help you diagnose illness that will allow your pet to live a healthier life!



WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE SERVICES?

Owners who have contacted SICSA looking to surrender their pet.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT WHEN I BRING MY PET FOR A BRIDGE APPOINTMENT?

- All Pets will receive a full physical exam, age appropriate vaccinations, deworming medication and flea prevention by a veterinarian. Treatment for conditions such as URI, conjunctivitis, diarrhea will be available for an extra nominal charge.
- Owners are expected to come to their scheduled appointment. Appointments will only be rescheduled for clients who call or email prior to their appointment time. No call/no show

appointments will not be rescheduled. To reschedule please call the Clinic Manager at 937/294-6505 ext. 14 or email mdell@SICSA.org

- Owners will receive documentation of the vaccinations and procedures completed at the visit.

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER MY APPOINTMENT?

- If your pet qualifies for the adoption program, your pet intake fee will be free or reduced (see pricing on next page.)
- If your pet does not qualify for our adoption program you can receive a discounted price on spay/neuter. (see pricing on next page.)
